They've assigned you to interrogate "Señorita Wright" to find out the following information:
 - how many paintings she's stolen;
 - how she stole them;
 - when she stole them; and
 - the current locations of the paintings.

You also need to find out basic background information regarding

- where she is from;
- her age;
- her REAL name; and
- any other questions that will assist Interpol with their investigation.
