

Ante la alerta de influenza pandémica o influenza aviar a nivel internacional, el Ministerio de Salud elabora un protocolo de atención prehospitalaria el cual permitirá proporcionar orientación sobre el control de infecciones a los trabajadores sanitarios de los centros hospitalarios que evalúen o brinden asistencia a pacientes que presentan una infección presunta o confirmada por el Virus H5N1.

Esta iniciativa, que incluye a otras instituciones estatales, persigue preparar al personal de salud en el período interpandémico, donde se han detectado nuevos subtipos del virus de la influenza en los seres humanos, pero sí un subtipo del virus de la influenza animal que circula y representa un riesgo considerable de enfermedad humana.

La epidemia es actualmente endémica en los pollos y el virus H5N1 (altamente patógeno) ha sido aislado de ciertas especies de aves migratorias, además de los seres humanos.
