You are in Paris sightseeing with friends when you suddenly realize your wallet or purse has disappeared. Then you remember that a person bumped you in the metro and you start to wonder if this was a robbery. You go to the police station to file a report, and a detective comes out to interview you. The detective tells you that a known band of pickpockets has been operating in the city preying on tourists, and asks you some questions to find out which member is responsible.

Before the interview, go ahead and gather your thoughts about what the person who bumped into you looks like and write comments below. By the way, the person who bumped into you looks EXACTLY like the picture the teacher showed you at the beginning of class, Coincidence? Probably not....Write comments about the person's gender, approximate age, height (tall, short, or medium), and hair (length and color) in complete sentences.
