(detective)

You are a police detective in Paris. There has been an outbreak of pickpocketing recently in the city by a ring of unlikely felons. One day, an American tourist comes in to report a theft. Based on the choice of victim and method of attack, you suspect that a member of the ring is the one responsible. You have pictures of the individual members of the gang, but you don't know which one actually did the job. You will interview the tourist and determine which member of the ring you need to pick up.

While the victim is waiting in front, go ahead and prepare some questions you are going to ask him/her about the suspected thief. Prepare questions about the gender, approximate age, height (tall, short, or medium), and hair (length and color) of the suspect.

Now, greet the victim and use the questions to conduct the interview. Write the victim's answers next to the questions.

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Finally, based on the description of the suspect, choose one of the people below to arrest and show the picture to the victim. Ask the victim if that's the person ("C'est lui?/C'est elle?"). Finally say goodbye and show the victim to the door.









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
