Description: First Sentence is a pre-reading activity that encourages students to make creative predictions about the reading material based on the first sentence of the text.

How It Works: First Sentence presents students with a series of questions based on the first sentence of a text. The questions encourage students to make predictions about the author, content, and purpose, as well as clarify their own interest in the subject.

How It Can Be Used: First Sentence is can be useful across all content areas, though it is often used in ELA classes with works of fiction.

- ♦ Students can revisit their answers to the First Sentence activity after reading the text to determine their accuracy of prediction.
- ♦ First Sentence can be useful for engaging students with text that may at first glance seem intimidating or uninteresting.
